Checklist for the Acceptance of a Dog/Cat in the Passenger Cabin

My animal is

clean and fit for travel

at least 12 weeks old (to/from /via Germany: 15 weeks), proving documentation is available

kept in a soft-sided transport bag during the entire stay on board in the foot space in front of my seat and stored under the front seat for take-off, landing, and during turbulences

My soft sided transport bag is

max. 118 cm (55 × 40 × 23 cm) and weighs up to max. 8 kg incl. animal

suitable for the animal's size. My cat/dog can sit, stand, turn and lie down in a natural position

closed during the entire flight

adequately ventilated even when closed

leak and escape proof

Checklist for the Acceptance of an Assistance or Search/Rescue Dog

My dog will

fit in the foot space in front of my seat

lie or sit on the floor in front of my seat, secured with a leash

not sit on a passenger seat under any circumstances

preferably be secured with a harness rather than a collar

The required transportation of recognized assistance dogs is guaranteed in accordance with the legal provisions.

I confirm to have read and understood following transport conditions:

It is my responsibility to ensure that all import, transfer and export regulations for the animal and the animal welfare provisions are met for the entire trip. I am holding all necessary documents (e.g. pet passport, vaccination certificate etc.).

My animal is trained to be obedient and behaves properly in public settings (i.e. no aggressive barking or growling).

Should my animal not meet the conditions listed above, the airline may confine the animal to the baggage compartment against a charge or even deny carriage. This applies in particular if the animal poses a danger to other passengers or the safety of flight operations. Snub-nosed breeds suffer from significant risks of mortality and secondary diseases due to respiratory distress and cannot be transported in the cargo hold. If such animal does not meet the criteria (as listed above) to be transported in the cabin, it will be denied carriage.
